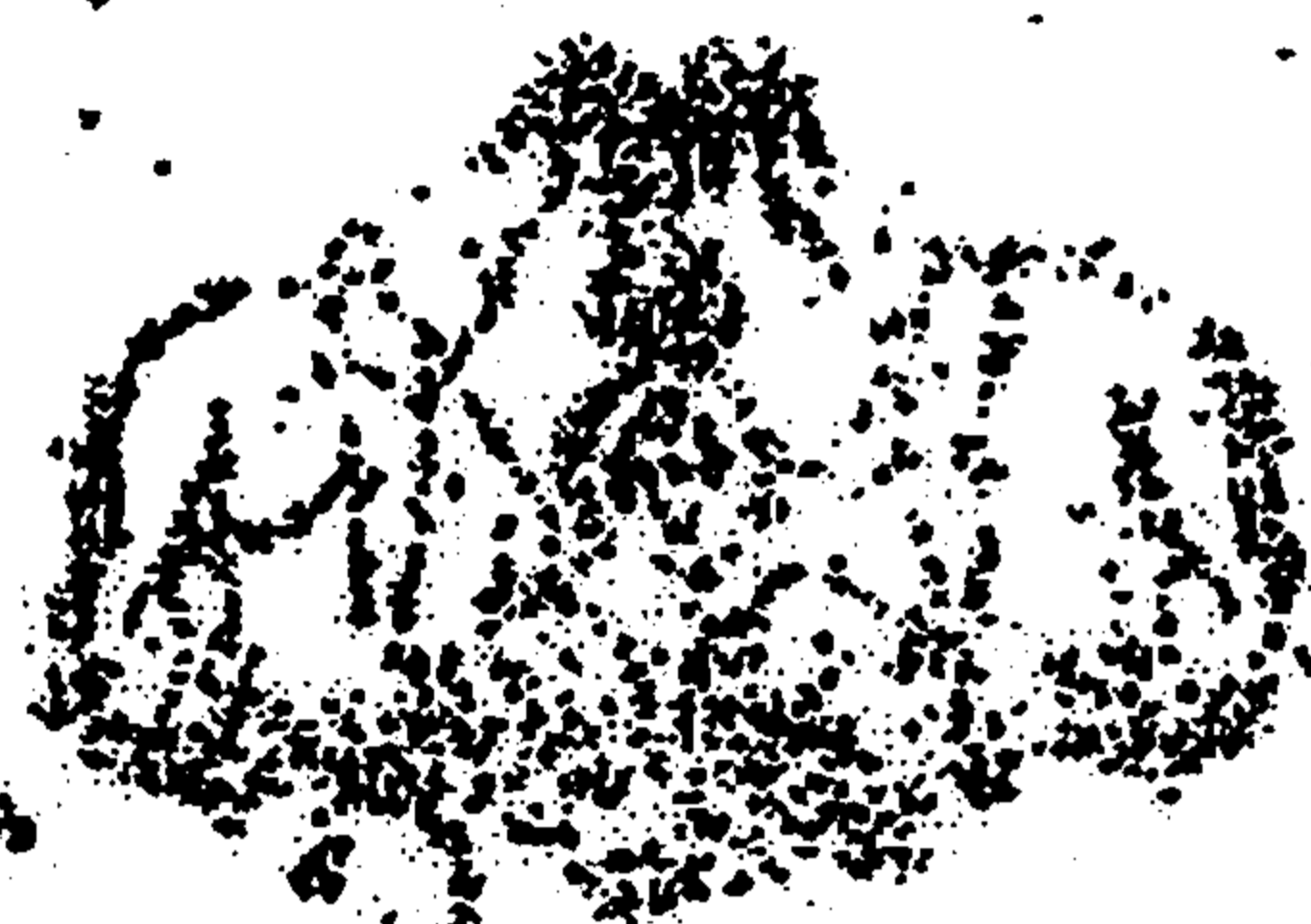

PUBLIC SERVICES—RECRUITMENT TO THE POST OF CONFIDENTIAL ASSISTANT, GRADE II FROM AMONG THE LOW PAID GOVERNMENT SERVANTS—ORDERS ISSUED

ORDER

According to the orders in the G. O. first read above, five per cent of the vacancies arising in the cadre of L. D. Clerk, L. D. Typist, Typist-clerk and Copyist are reserved for persons holding low paid posts who secure not less than 40% marks in the competitive test conducted by the Public Service Commission for selection to the above posts. In the G. O. second read above, the above concession was extended to the selection to the post of Typist, Grade II in the Secretariat, in the offices of the Public Service Commission, the Advocate General and the Examiner of Local Fund Accounts subject to the condition that the low paid employees who possess

the minimum typewriting examination prescribed for the post alone will be allowed to appear for the competitive test conducted by the Public Service Commission for selection to such posts. In the G. O. third read above, two per cent of vacancies arising in the cadre of Assistant, Grade II/Grade II Auditor are also reserved for persons holding low paid posts with four years aggregate service, in their respective category of posts and having the minimum educational qualification prescribed for appointment to the post of Assistant, Grade II/Grade II Auditor for direct recruitment. Those who secure not less than 40% marks in the competitive test conducted by the Public Service Commission will be selected for appointment to the post.

2. But there is no reservation for the persons holding low paid post in the matter of appointment to the post of Confidential Assistant. Vacancies of Confidential Assistants are filled up by direct recruitment and by promotion from qualified Typists in the ratio of 1 : 1.

3. Government have examined the proposal for giving concession to the low paid employees in the matter of appointment to the post of Confidential Assistant Grade II in consultation with the Public Service Commission and they are pleased to order that two per cent of vacancies of Confidential Assistants, Grade II set apart for direct recruitment will be reserved for appointment of low paid employees included in the Last Grade Service and Subordinate Services who possess the minimum qualifications prescribed for appointment of Confidential Assistant, Grade II and who secure not less than forty per cent marks in the competitive test conducted by the Public Service Commission.

4. Following the procedure prescribed in the G. O. fifth read above, the names of the low paid employees who secure 40% marks and above in the selective test conducted by the Public Service Commission and thus became qualified for appointment as Confidential Assistant, Grade II but could not secure appointment before the expiry of the ranked list will be included at the top of the new separate ranked list of the low paid employees irrespective of their service and seniority and they will be given appointment accordingly.
